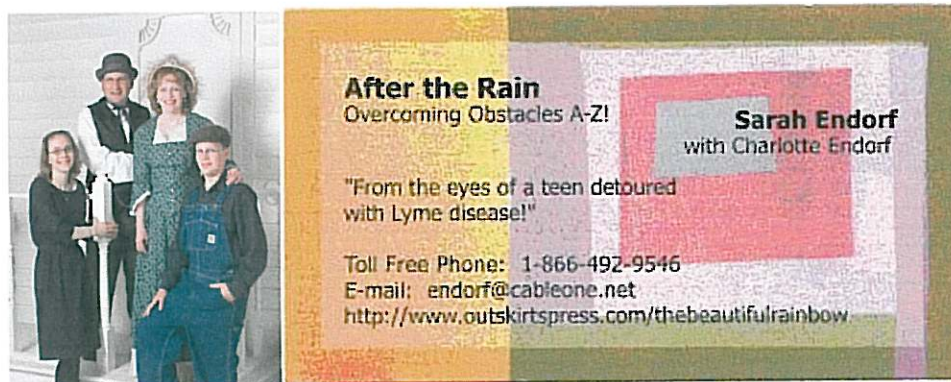


*"Family Makes A Positive Out of a Negative Helping Many Along the Way!"*

While Sarah has recovered she has accomplished lots! She will turn seventeen this week yet has more on her resume than many! She's finished her education via the local college GED program a year and one half ahead of her high school class! She'll begin college in January!

She and her mother, Charlotte, co-authored an inspirational/motivational book July 2005 *After the Rain, Oh the Beautiful Rainbow!* Readers of all ages are inspired by Sarah's powerful lessons. Sarah's a firm believer that truly happy people are those that can enjoy the scenery on a detour!

January 2006 Sarah illustrated *Plains Bound: Fragile Cargo* for her mother. Charlotte traveled 3,000 miles interviewing the last of the orphan train riders who are aged 80 and 90 and their descendants. The family dresses in 1800's attire bringing the book to life with their skits *Excess Baggage* and *N-E-B-R-A-S-K-A-N-S*. They are having the time of their lives teaching this little known American History while keeping their focus off of Sarah's illness. It's a win-win situation for all!
